

## 2008 Jazz in the Pines

Dear Artist:

The well-attended, critically acclaimed 15th annual **JAZZ IN THE PINES** will be held on Saturday and Sunday, August 23<sup>rd</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>, 2008. Sponsored by the **Associates of Idyllwild Arts Foundation**, it will be in the scenic outdoor amphitheater of the Idyllwild Arts campus in the exquisite pine forest and refreshing mountain air.

There will be a major headliner on each day. We expect a great attendance – as many as 4000+ persons moving between continuous and wide-ranging jazz performances in three varied settings: Holmes Amphitheatre, French Quarter Bistro and Stephens Recital Hall. So that you may judge foot traffic, the three jazz venues are marked on the enclosed map. You may choose any available space and that site will be reserved when your check is received. Please see the map on which I have marked the available spaces as of today in **blue**. Any requested spot will be allotted in the order received, i.e., by the postmark of the application and check. Please consider if you prefer sun or shade and how level the space must be, as each one is different. Telephone me for more info on each space you may be considering.

The weekend rental of Art Booth space is TBD for 2008. Two persons per booth per day will receive entry to the festival as well as one parking permit per day. We normally invite only handcrafted work by the artist. Artists are responsible for their own exhibits, including insurance and license. Electricity is not available. An overhead shelter (e.g., a pop-up canopy) is required to protect the booths from sun and inclement weather. **You must have a valid resale license**. It is required that I submit it to the County well in advance of the festival.

A supply of **Jazz in the Pines 2008** brochures will be sent to you a few weeks before the event if you reserve an art space, as well as the necessary documentations. We very much hope you will choose to be part of this glorious, jubilant and worthy event.
